A skipper's briefing is designed to reduce any possible risk for the crew while onboard. It is so important for your crew to stay safe and to know what to do if something goes wrong.

## 1. Basic safety

- △ Life vest location and usage
- △ First aid kit location
- △ Flares location
- △ Fire extinguisher location
- △ VHF usage
- △ Gangway check
- △ How to turn off the autopilot
- △ Basic steering and motoring
- △ Emergency call numbers 112 and 195

## 3. Boat usage

- △ Toilet & waste tanks usage
- △ Gas valve location
- △ Water pumps and taps usage
- △ Cabin lights switches location
- △ Electricity and water saving
- △ Caution regarding hatches
- △ Locking the boat
- △ Where to hide the keys
- △ Dingy handling

## 2. Safety while sailing

- △ Closing hatches
- △ Securing movable objects
- △ Closing drawers, closets, door etc.
- △ Winch & winch handles usage
- △ Danger of lines
- △ How to walk on a heeled boat
- △ Avoiding boom in motion

## 4. Assisting your skipper

- △ Mooring lines usage
- △ Anchor usage
- △ Grabbing the buoy

- △ Sun protection & dehydration prevention
- △ Kids on the boat
